2. 4-6 snacks with high calories and protein. Please select snacks with long shelf life –granola bars, protein bars, cheese and crackers, fruit snacks, canned fruit (with pull-off top), or Pop-Tarts
3. Mini first aid kit (can be found at Dollar-Tree)
4. 1 extra pair of underwear/ or Pull-Ups
5. Germ-X Wipes Individual pack
6. A family picture
7. A small age appropriate toy
