*As partners, we share the responsibility for our children's success and want you to know that we will do our very best to carry out our responsibilities. We ask that you guide and support your child's learning by ensuring that he/she:*

1. Arrives to school well rested and is kept on a regular schedule to maximize on learning time .Structured activities begin at 8:30 a.m.-12 noon. All half-day students need to be picked up no later than 12:30 p.m.
2. Follows classroom and school rules of- "Being kind with your hands, feet, and mouth!"
3. Brings a nutritional lunch from home. We encourage healthy foods and ask that parents to please NOT SEND items such as donuts, large bag of chips, and candy in lunch boxes for breakfast or lunch. Let's save the sweet treats for special occasions like classroom parties and holidays!
4. Is ready for school daily!
  - ✓ HW folder is returned (PreK/TK)
  - ✓ Extra clothes (full-set) is always available in their cubby
  - ✓ Child is healthy and free of fever, vomiting, and diarrhea
  - ✓ Bedding- **1 fitted crib sheet and a light covering** (Full-time students) is taken home on Friday to be laundered and returned on Monday.
