As partners, we share the responsibility for our children's success and want you to know that we will do our very best to carry out our responsibilities. We ask that you guide and support your child's learning by ensuring that he/she:

1. Arrives to school well rested and is kept on a regular schedule to maximize on learning time. Structured activities begin at 8:30 a.m.-12 noon. All half-day students need to be picked up no later than 12:30 p.m.
2. Follows classroom and school rules of- "Being kind with your hands, feet, and mouth!"
3. Brings a nutritional lunch from home. We encourage healthy foods and ask that parents **DO NOT SEND items such as donuts, large bag of chips, and candy in lunch boxes or for breakfast.**

Let's save the sweet treats for special occasions like classroom parties and holidays!

4. Is ready for school daily!
  - ✓ HW folder is returned (PreK/TK)
  - ✓ Extra clothes (full-set) is always available in their cubby
  - ✓ Child is healthy and free of fever, vomiting, and diarrhea
  - ✓ Bedding- **1 fitted crib sheet and a light covering** (Full-time students) is taken home on Friday to be laundered and returned on Monday.

## **Things to look out for this school year!**

- A revised curriculum supplement to enhance our 3 year olds-TK. Mother Goose curriculum will be added to our daily learning to provide a better understanding of words, literacy, and language development for our little ones.
- A sight word incentive program for our Pre-K/TK students will continue- **Sight Word Super Heroes**. Students who master their sight words from Sept.-May, will receive monthly incentives and an opportunity to win a grand prize at the end of the school year!
